
**DATA PROTECTION PRIVACY NOTICE
(RECRUITMENT)**

1. Data protection privacy notice (recruitment)

This notice explains what personal data (information) we will hold about you, how we collect it, and how we will use and may share information about you during the application process. We are required to notify you of this information, under data protection legislation. Please ensure that you read this notice (sometimes referred to as a 'privacy notice') and any other similar notice we may provide to you from time to time when we collect or process personal information about you.

2. Who collects the information

Mundays LLP (the "**Firm**") is a 'data controller' and gathers and uses certain information about you.

3. Data protection principles

We will comply with the data protection principles when gathering and using personal information, as set out in our data protection policy.

4. About the information we collect and hold

4.1 The table below summarises the information we may collect and hold, how and why we do so, how we use it and with whom it may be shared.

4.2 We seek to ensure that our information collection and processing is always proportionate. We will notify you of any changes to information we collect or to the purposes for which we collect and process it.

5. Where information may be held

Information may be held at our offices and third party agencies, service providers, representatives and agents as described above.

6. How long we keep your information

6.1 We keep the personal information that we obtain about you during the recruitment process for no longer than is necessary for the purposes for which it is processed. How long we keep your information will depend on whether your application is successful and you become employed by us, the nature of the information concerned and the purposes for which it is processed.

6.2 We will keep recruitment information (including interview notes) for no longer than is reasonable, taking into account the limitation periods for potential claims such as race or sex discrimination (as extended to take account of early conciliation), and any relevant contractual terms with any recruiter who may have introduced you to us after which they will be destroyed. If there is a clear business reason for keeping recruitment records for longer than the recruitment period, we may do so but will first consider whether the records can be pseudonymised, and the longer period for which they will be kept.

6.3 If your application is successful, we will keep only the recruitment information that is necessary in relation to your employment. For further information, see our privacy notice (employment).

7. Your rights to correct and access your information and to ask for it to be erased

Please contact our HR department if (in accordance with applicable law) you would like to correct or request access to information that we hold relating to you or if you have any questions about this notice. You also have the right to ask our HR department for some but not all of the information we hold and process to be erased (the 'right to be forgotten') in certain circumstances. Our HR Department will provide you with further information about the right to be forgotten, if you ask for it.

8. Keeping your personal information secure

8.1 We have appropriate security measures in place to prevent personal information from being accidentally lost, or used or accessed in an unauthorised way. We limit access to your personal information to those who have a genuine business need to know it. Those processing your information will do so only in an authorised manner and are subject to a duty of confidentiality.

8.2 We also have procedures in place to deal with any suspected data security breach. We will notify you and any applicable regulator of a suspected data security breach where we are legally required to do so.

9. How to complain

We hope that our Data Protection Officer can resolve any query or concern you raise about our use of your information.
